INFRASTRUCTURE ASSET MANAGEMENT

(2 + 3 CPD POINTS)

Block 1: 20 & 21 February 2017 & Block 2: 3 -5 May 2017

A short course in Infrastructure Asset Management will be presented at the Chair in Construction Engineering and Management of the Department of Civil Engineering at Stellenbosch University.

Industry participants are invited to attend the course for either 2, 3 or 5 CPD points (20 & 21 February 2017, and/or 3 to 5 May 2017).

The Chair aims to develop management practices for managers at all levels and in all spheres of the built environment, be it from the side of the client, designer, contractor or user. It also aims to equip engineers and allied professionals in the industry with some of the necessary background to understand the challenges of the construction environment.

The purpose of this course in Infrastructure Asset Management is to address the management practices required for the implementation and maintenance of municipal infrastructure. The first block will commence with the background to infrastructure asset management, including the need in the national context. Legislation will be addressed as well as available and current strategies for infrastructure asset planning and management. The course will include the methodology for setting up an asset register. A field exercise will be undertaken to expose participants to the compilation of an actual asset register.

Block two will address ISO55000 and the need for asset management standard. The lectures will comprise of modules on asset intervention strategies and intervention programmes. Block two will also address the principles and development of a data base which forms the essence of asset registers. Examples of local and European asset management programmes will be presented.

The following persons should attend the course on Infrastructure Asset Management:

- Managers, engineers and other persons at local authorities who are involved in infrastructure planning and management and who need a thorough understanding of the principles involved in the process.
- Managers, engineers and allied professionals at consulting practices involved with the services offered to local authorities in Infrastructure Asset Management.
- Managers, engineers and allied professionals at construction companies who are involved in the implementation and maintenance of municipal infrastructure.
