



SHORT COURSE IN CONSTRUCTION SAFETY

Offered by The Chair in Construction Engineering and Management



COURSE DISCRIPTION

A short course on construction safety will be presented by the Chair in Construction Engineering and Management at the Department of Civil Engineering of Stellenbosch University. The course is offered on 22 August 2019 as part of an academic module in the post graduate programme in Construction Engineering and Management. Industry participants can attend this one day as a non-academic participant. **CPD points** will be awarded to industry participants for attending.

OBJECTIVE

The course aims to create awareness for the importance of construction safety as it impacts on the owner, designer and contractor. Whilst the Construction Regulations will be used as basis, the objective is also to highlight the role of the designer and his/her role in safety management.

LANGUAGE

The course will be presented in English.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The course will be of interest to professionals in all branches of the construction industry. Professionals who are not familiar with the Construction Regulations should attend, and also those who are keen to learn about the role of the designer in making projects safer during construction. The focus in case studies will be on structural works. Whilst employees from construction companies will benefit directly, consultants and client representatives will also gain a better understanding of their role in safety management. The course will be of most value for young professionals with up to 5 to 7 years experience.

BRIEF OVEVIEW OF COURSE CONTENT

- Requirements imposed on employers and their representatives as set out in the Occupational Health and Safety Act No. 85 Of 1993
- Requirements imposed on employees and on contractors as set out in the Construction Regulations GNR. 84 of 7th February 2014.
- Description of the process that needs to be followed by the client prior to tender.
- Description of the process that needs to be followed by the principal contractor at tender stage and after award.
- Design for construction safety by considering structural projects.



- To discuss the other Regulations that have influence on a construction site.
- Afternoon session: A case study discussion by delegates with feedback of a structural project to identify ways and means for the designer and the contractor to address construction safety on a structural project.
